

»Others may wage wars, you, happy Austria, marry.« Despite the fact that this maxim held true for many centuries, the era of the Habsburgs was by no means always blessed with peace. They knew no mercy in their struggle for the crown and for power. Many a wedlock that initially appeared auspicious proved ill-starred and problematic. It was the exception rather than the rule that these marriages, arranged for reasons of political expedience, were happy.

In this volume, the author describes the intensely private trials and tribulations of the ruling dynasty, but also gives us a glimpse of the Habsburgs' days of glory. Sigrid-Maria Größing has a special gift for recounting the history of Austria and its great rulers in a style both engrossing and accessible.
