At present, the eighty-three-year-old is the director of research of the William Harvey Research Institute and the Royal London School of Medicine and Dentistry. He lives with his family in England.

Lorie Karnath is a close friend of Gustav Born. She is a member of the NFCR Board and managing director of International Rescentris. She also works for the National Foundation for Cancer Research and is the representative of the committee for Nobel Prize winners in Lindau. She has published numerous articles on science, business and research. Lorie Karnath met Amalie at a family gathering of the Born family in the Black Forest.
