

Aboard the boat of Rollo Gebhard, the legendary sailor,

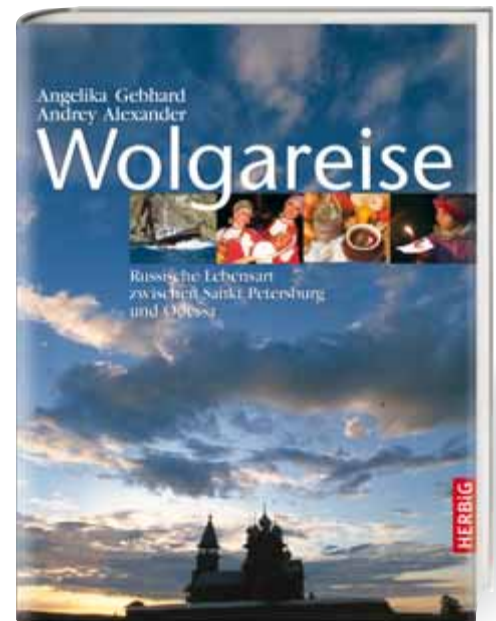
