→ This visual adventure in 3-D is terrific fun for the great and the small fans of the wild animals of Africa.

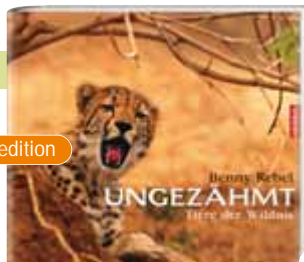
